2019 got straight off to a busy start, as over the Christmas and New Year closure the mill got a new set of mill stones. The works were overseen by specialist local millwright Ian Clark and means that Eling Tide Mill can continue to mill for many years to come. Ian said "I'm really happy with how these works have gone, with old machinery and buildings, despite planning, you never really know what might happen".
