The former owner and miller at **Sheet Bridge Mill, David Ellis,** died on 30th November, 2010. Born into the well known milling family, which owned mills in Hampshire and Sussex, in 1926, David worked at Sheet Bridge Mill near Petersfield with his brother Clive, producing animal feed. After the mill was sold the two brothers became partners in a successful property development business. David lived in another family owned mill, Liss.
